Our Cancer Program offers the full spectrum of outpatient treatments options in our Hematology/Oncology Clinic, Infusion Centers, IV Therapy Center, and Radiation Oncology Department. Our office hours are Monday through Friday from 8am to 5pm.

### **MyKelseyOnline**

MyKelseyOnline (MKO) is a secure patient portal that allows you to communicate with your healthcare team and view your test results online. MKO is easy to use and comes at no cost to you.

While MKO facilitates convenient communication between patients and physicians, it should not be used for urgent health care issues. For urgent concerns, please call our office or seek emergency care instead of sending messages through MKO.

To sign up for an MKO account, log on to **MyKelseyOnline.com** and follow the step-by-step instructions. If you need help creating or using your MKO account, please call the MKO Help Line at **713-442-6565**.

### **Prescription Refills**

If you need a prescription refill, we recommend contacting your pharmacy directly. Your pharmacy will contact us for any refills that need your physician's approval. Please allow a minimum of 3 working days for refills in case your refill requires additional steps such as prior authorization.

## **Symptoms to Report to Your Cancer Treatment Team**

Our healthcare professionals are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. To speak with a nurse during regular business hours, please call us at **713-442-1081**. It is important that you let our office know if you are experiencing any of the following symptoms:

- o Fever greater than or equal to 100.5 F
- o Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath (report to ER or call 911 if severe or sudden)
- o Prolonged nausea or vomiting (4+ episodes in a 24-hour period)
- o Frequent diarrhea (4+ episodes in a 24-hour period)
- o Prolonged constipation
- o Mouth sores and/or pain when swallowing
- o New or increased numbness or tingling of hands and/or feet
- o Signs of bleeding, such as unusual bruising, blood in stool or urine, or tarry stools
- o A wound that isn't healing or that appears infected
- o New or increased swelling of the hands, arms, legs, or feet
- o IV or port site redness, swelling, or drainage
- o Other new or worsening symptoms

For after-hours assistance, please call **713-442-0000**. You can access this service after regular business hours Monday through Friday and on weekends and holidays. Just follow the prompts of the automated system and your call will be directed to the appropriate personnel.
